Fiuggi (located in Latium Region, province of Frosinone) is still a small mediaeval town, a place of ancient traditions that has known how to preserve its pace of life, its culture and its natural beauty. The best way to be caught up in the spirit of Fiuggi is to explore the maze of little streets climbing up through the village. You can wander into the heart of Fiuggi, venturing into steep, narrow alleys, with a succession of old houses, archways, little squares and stone stairways. At certain times of the day, there is only the sound of footsteps to keep you company and the mediaeval atmosphere is constantly pervading your imagination. In some parts of the town, the original structure has been preserved, and sections of tower from the old defensive walls are visible here and there.

As well as the “upper” section of the village (the older part) you can also visit the lower town, where the springs are located. Indeed, Fiuggi is famous for its mineral water, and its therapeutic virtue has been universally recognised.

Fiuggi, in addition to being one of the most popular spa towns in Italy, will surprise visitors with its artistic and historic beauty. In the surrounding area, in addition to monasteries, castles, villages and archaeological sites, you will also find amusement parks, museums and nature itineraries, in the midst of scenic mountains, hills, secular forests and crystal-clear rivers.
